Rumpke Provides Special Seats for “Thunder”

600 portable toilets ready for Thunder Over Louisville patrons

LOUISVILLE, Ky.—April 16, 2009— Rumpke is installing 600 portable toilets Friday for the Kentucky Derby Festival’s Opening Ceremonies at Thunder Over Louisville.

Rumpke has provided portable toilets and trash service for the event since 2001. This week, Rumpke will place 600 portable toilets—including wheelchair accessible units—along the riverfront to accommodate a crowd anticipated at 500,000.

Rumpke will begin collecting 1,200 trash receptacles as well as the portable toilets at midnight following the event. The clean up is expected to take about seven hours.
