City of Bexley Guidelines

General Service Guidelines

- Place trash in bags or containers, not exceeding 50 pounds each.
- Place recycling in a labeled recycling container.
- Place trash, recycling and yard waste at the designated location the evening before the service day.

Rolling Carts (contact Rumpke to rent)

95-Gal Trash Cart

You may furnish your own trash container or rent a rolling trash cart from Rumpke.

\$3.00 per month



65-Gal Recycling Cart

Upgrade your recycling bin to a rolling cart with **TRIPLE** the space.

Bulky Items & Appliances

Rumpke will collect bulky household items from the curb on your trash service day. *Examples: Appliances, carpet, furniture, large toys.* Contact Rumpke for information about items with Freon.

Yard Waste Guidelines

Yard waste is organic waste generated during regular household gardening and landscaping such as grass clippings, leaves, twigs, branches, and shrubbery. Unacceptable yard waste includes plastic bags, pots, food waste, rocks and dirt.

- **Branches:** Cut branches to 4 ft. or shorter. Tie into bundles with string or twine (no wider than 2 ft.).
- **Loose Material:** Place in biodegradable bags or rigid containers marked "Yard Waste." **Do not line with plastic bags.**
- **Weight Limit:** Each bag, bundle or container should not exceed 50 pounds.
- **Holiday Trees:** Remove decorations then cut trunk and limbs to 4 ft. or shorter. Tie into bundles with string or twine.

Recycling Guidelines

Contact your municipality's office for information about additional recycling containers.

What To Recycle:

Combine recyclables unbagged in your recycling container. No need to separate.
