GLASS BOTTLES & JARS



- Plastic bottles, jugs, tubs, cups and clear clamshell containers
- Glass bottles and jars (remove the top from jars) and recycle them separately. Throw away bottle caps and wine corks)
- Greeting cards (no non-paper accessories or ones that play music)
- Envelopes
- Wrapping paper (paper only, no foil)

- Newspapers, catalogues, junk mail and magazines
- Gift, shoe and candy boxes
- Paper Amazon mailers
- Ory food paper boxes
- Paper grocery and gift bags
- Aluminum, steel and tin food and drink cans
- Pizza boxes (no food or grease)

NAUGHTY LIST: UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

These items are not accepted at our recycling facilities. They can cause damage to the equipment or even pose a risk to employees and nearby communities.

Batteries

- Lithium-ion (phones, power tools, electric vehicles, etc.)
- Lead Acid (vehicles, boats)
- Alkaline (AAA, AA, D-volt)
- Electronics
- S Foil wrapping paper
- Tissue paper
- Aluminum foil, pie tins and casserole or roasting pans
- Ribbons and bows

- Plastic bags
- Styrofoam—search for a local drop-off location!
- 2 Packing peanuts and bubble wrap
- Plastic toys
- Textiles (clothing, bed sheets, etc.)
- Plants and trees
- Holiday lights
- Ceramic and drinkware
- Plastic wrap
- Ornaments
- Décor (wreaths and garlands, etc.)
